As I look back upon 2019, I am overwhelmed by the progress Leveling the Playing Field was able to make here in the Baltimore community. I knew it would be difficult to top the energy of our first year - but we did just that! Not only did LPF grow by every possible metric, we also saw the organic growth of our mission here in Baltimore:

- We connected with new volunteer collectors who had heard about LPF from friends, teammates, and neighbors.
- We worked with new volunteer groups through community partner recommendations.
- We donated to new programs after ongoing teachers and coaches shared our application.

All of this contributed to another remarkable year of getting local kids off the sidelines.

One of the most consistent themes of 2019 was the power of partnerships. LPF Baltimore kicked off the year with an unprecedented in-kind donation of compression shirts and sports bras from Under Armour. In May 2019, the Baltimore Ravens donated a brand new Ford T-250 Cargo Van and 6ft enclosed trailer to LPF Baltimore - a donation totalling more than \$40,000!

Since its establishment in early 2018, LPF Baltimore has had to rent cargo vans and UHaul trucks in order to pick up sporting equipment donations, participate in community events, and transport materials. With the new addition of the van and trailer, LPF Baltimore is able to mobilize quickly and efficiently to a range of opportunities. The cargo van is used to pick up and transport sporting equipment from various collection drives and donation sites. The trailer is used as a mobile donation site, allowing us to run multiple collection drives at once and build brand awareness at local events.

The van and trailer have already proved to be a be a game changer for LPF Baltimore. We are incredibly grateful for the continued support of the Baltimore Ravens organization and look forward to many future collections, distributions, and community events with the LPF Baltimore van and trailer!
