Last year, as our warehouses filled back up with PE teachers and coaches, we heard the same challenge across programs. Many kids' social-emotional learning skills and physical health are still stunted from the pandemic.

In response to these continued challenges, we have seen renewed efforts to make youth sports and recreation more accessible, especially for students in under-resourced communities. As a result, LPF experienced unprecedented demand for our equipment resources and we had our busiest year yet. We cannot thank our donors, volunteers, teams, businesses, families, and overall community enough for the support in 2022 which has helped us get more kids off the sidelines across all three of our markets.

Here are some highlights from the past year:

- **Our Growing LPF Team** - LPF added two additional staff members to our team in 2022 that have helped increase our capacity to serve.
- **Increased Partnerships** - LPF worked with more partners than ever, including professional sports teams & leagues, manufacturers, businesses, and other nonprofits. These partnerships helped LPF have a broader impact across all three of our markets.
- **Metric Milestones** - LPF had a record-breaking year in terms of collection, volunteers, programs served, and distribution metrics. All of these numbers translate to even more kids having the opportunity to play sports.

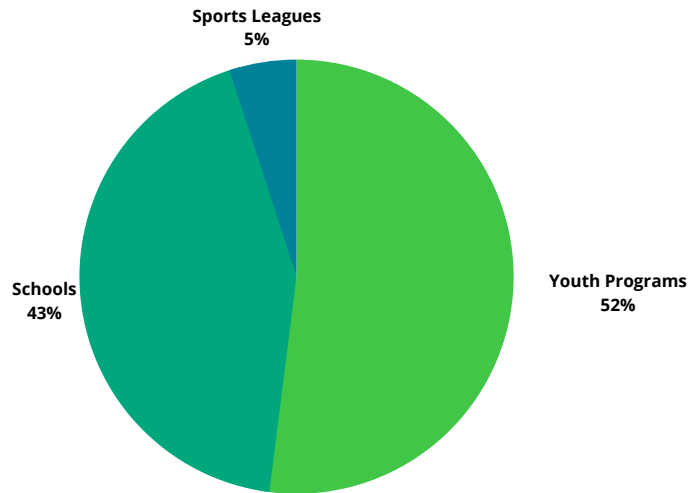

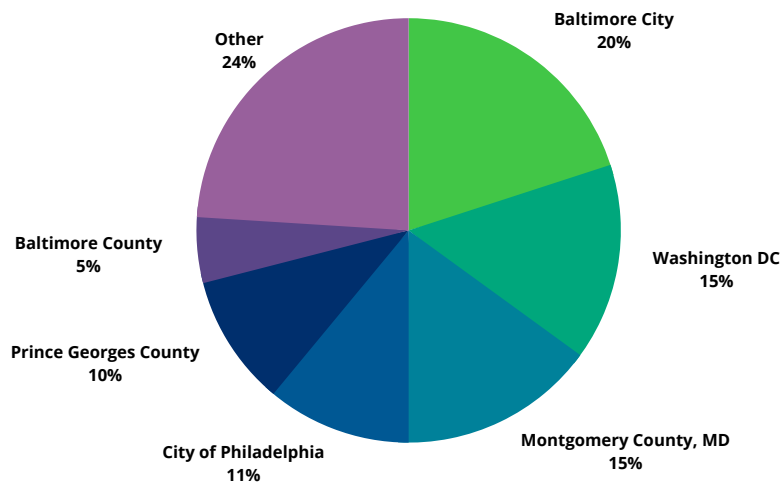

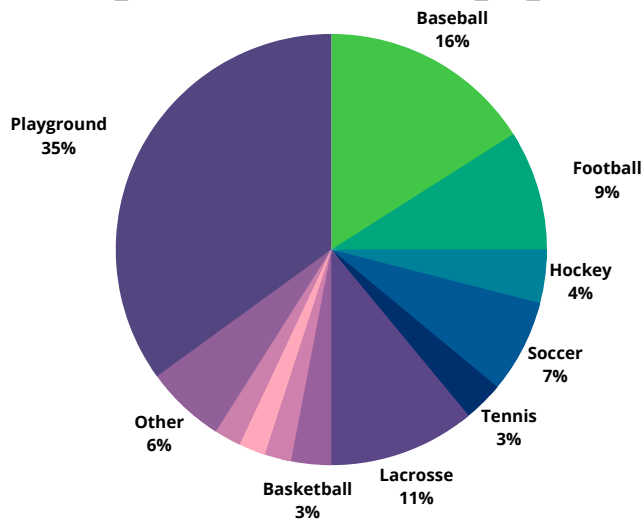

SPORTS BRA DONATIONS

In 2022, we celebrated the 50th anniversary of Title IX and the incredible impact it has had on girls and women having access to sports. LPF was able to use this incredible milestone to highlight an ongoing equipment barrier facing girls in under-resourced communities: sports bras.

LPF set out on an ambitious goal of collecting over 10,000 new, quality sports bras in 2022 to help local female student-athletes in need. In March 2022, LPF helped to establish the Washington Coalition of Women's Professional Sports (WCWPS) alongside the Washington Spirit, DC Divas, DC Shadow, and Washington Mystics to bring added visibility and resources to help girls around the DMV access sports. With the support of Nike, Champion/Hanes Brands, and local supporters, LPF was able to collect over 11,000 in DC alone!

Additionally, LPF worked with the Philadelphia Eagles to distribute nearly 6,000 new sports bras to local girls to help launch their new girls' flag football league. Throughout the year, LPF was able to collect over **17,000 NEW sports bras** and has been distributing them throughout our markets to ensure ALL girls have the gear they need to be comfortable and confident on the field.



RURAL POP-UPS!

In order to better serve PE teachers within our more rural communities, LPF expanded our "Pop-Up" Distribution Program with partners within Worcester County, MD and Washington County, MD. Our staff worked closely with these school districts to identify their PE teachers' particular needs, packed up our van & trailer full of gear, and then set up a "Pop-Up" distribution site right at their own facility. These activations brought much needed equipment resources to areas that would otherwise have difficulty accessing our warehouse.

Throughout the year, **LPF donated over \$50,000 worth of sporting equipment to 30 schools** along the Eastern Shore and in Western Maryland. We are grateful to the Community Foundation of the Eastern Shore and the Community Foundation of Washington County, MD for their support and look forward to growing the LPF "Pop-Up" Distribution Program in 2023!



LPF CLEATS DAYS

Throughout 2022, LPF hosted a number of cleat days where we brought a wide range of cleat sizes & styles to partner sites so that kids could have direct, personalized access to free cleats. Through a partnership with the **Maryland State Youth Soccer Association**, LPF was able to provide cleats to every participant of their "Let's Play" introductory soccer program. In total, we donated over 1,700 pairs of cleats across 20+ cleat day events.



LPF - PHILADELPHIA OPENS FOR DISTRIBUTION

After launching our LPF Philadelphia warehouse in November 2021, our program staff had the task of filling an empty warehouse with sports equipment. Fortunately, the Philadelphia youth sports community heard the call to action and delivered. By the end of February 2022, LPF Philadelphia was overflowing with sports equipment and ready to open the warehouse doors to local PE teachers, coaches, and other youth programs in need.

From March 2022 through the end of the year, **LPF Philadelphia was able to distribute over \$530,000 worth of sporting equipment to 164 local schools, sports leagues, and other youth programs in need.** This accelerated pace from empty warehouse to robust distribution was unexpected and speaks to the amazing support of the Philadelphia community.

In 2023, we expect LPF Philadelphia to continue this incredible upward trajectory and continue to expand access for local kids to play sports.



LPF SELECTED AS 2022 NWSL CHAMPIONSHIP CHARITABLE PARTNER

Throughout the year, LPF had the opportunity to partner with the National Women's Soccer League (NWSL). At the start of the NWSL season, the Washington Spirit selected LPF to be their partner for the **Nationwide Community Impact Award**, a season-long, civically-focused initiative that promotes community and local service projects chosen and led by each NWSL team. LPF worked closely with the Spirit and star-player Ashley Hatch to raise awareness and collect new sports bras for girls in need across the DMV.

This partnership came with a \$10,000 award and culminated with an activation at Excel Academy, DCPS's only all-girls school, where students had the opportunity to hear directly from professional players Andi Sullivan, Gaby Vincent, and Ashley Hatch, as well as esteemed female representatives from the DC Mayor's Office. Additionally, the girls were able to go "swag shopping" for brand new athletic apparel and sports bras.

With the NWSL Championship hosted at Audi Field in October 2022, LPF was also fortunate enough to be selected as the official charitable partner of the championship. The NWSL worked with Match Worn Shirt to auction off player jerseys from the Portland Thorns and the Kansas City Current. The auction was able to raise over \$28,000 and LPF received the proceeds to support our work around gender equity.
